North Shropshire MP visits Our Space



North Shropshire MP Helen Morgan and her colleague Mary Davies met with representatives from Bethphage at Our Space Community Centre and Library in Ellesmere. Our Chair of Trustees, Derek Lum, Trustee Ruth Houghton, CEO, Stef Kay and Our Space Manager, Rachel Davies were also accompanied by Ellesmere Mayor, Anne Wignall who was there to highlight the community food share service that is operated from Our Space.

Helen was keen to hear about the different work being undertaken at Our Space as well as discuss the challenges facing the sector. She was interested to understand how much of the local authorities' budgets are spent on learning disability and autism and learn about the difficulties in recruiting new staff, resulting in needing to recruit people who need a work visa.

Rachel gave Helen a tour of the building and introduced her to people whilst explaining the range of person-centred services provided at Our Space.

The team work incredibly hard to create a lovely environment in which people can access the support they need in a safe community environment, particularly for adults with learning disabilities, autism and older people."
