"I have faced mobility issues and various health challenges since 2019. However, I firmly believe that, regardless of our personal struggles, we can all contribute to making a difference. That's why I've decided to embark on a meaningful journey.

This endeavor was incredibly difficult due to exhaustion and chronic pain related to my various health conditions and mobility issues. I have EDS, fibromyalgia and numerous other conditions, which meant that 35 miles was a big challenge and I'm so proud to have met the mileage goal early!

Bethphage's dedication to improving the lives of the people they support resonates with me deeply. My daughter, Lucy, is a dedicated member of the Bethphage team, and her commitment to their mission has shown me the profound impact of their work. Also, my stepdaughter, Emily, benefits from organisations like Bethphage in the area she resides in. Bethphage was established in Shropshire 1994 by our American founder and now honorary president, Donna Werner. Donna opened our first registered care home, "Viewmount" in Whitchurch where we supported 5 people coming out of long stay hospital. Since then, we have gradually grown as an organisation and now employ around 350 staff, supporting over 200 people in a range of settings, Registered Care, Supported Living, Shared Lives and Day Opportunities across Shropshire, Telford and the West Midlands

Spotlight on: Shared Lives

Shared Lives is an alternative way to provide support to those who need it. People supported by Shared Lives live in the family home of our approved "Shared Lives Carers" on a full or temporary basis.

We had a support referral for May* two years ago, she was living with a friend of the family and rarely left the house, other than to attend an educational centre one morning a week. She lacked confidence and was craving the feeling of community.





Following a meeting with our Shared Lives officer and potential carers, May quickly moved into her new home with her Shared Lives carers. She found her feet in her new community quickly with support from her carers. May went to the educational centre more often and began to volunteer at a local food waste charity. Before long, she secured a volunteer job at a charity shop and even became a keyholder.

May has continued to thrive in her Shared Lives placement and has grown in confidence, she is such an important part of her local community. She has recently secured a paid job at a local fast-food restaurant and loves meeting new people!
