Bethphage acquires Lower Sutton Farm



We're excited to announce the purchase of Lower Sutton Farm in Shropshire. This farm will provide day opportunities for adults with learning disabilities and autism, focusing on horticulture, animal husbandry, and craft skills. We'll grow produce, run a farm shop, and actively engage with the local community.

With a farmhouse, 12 acres, and numerous outbuildings, this site has lots of potential which we want to explore. We aim to launch within the next year and will keep you updated on our progress.

Bethphage's CEO Stef Kay said:

"This is a fantastic opportunity for Bethphage as this site has so much potential. There are exciting possibilities for us to consider, there is already planning permission in place for two four-bedroom residential properties, and we have other ideas we will be exploring in the future subject to consulting with all stakeholders. Right now, our focus is on the initial work required to have the site up and running as a working farm within 6 to 12 months."
